MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

Between

Bundelkhand University, Jhansi (India) AND Aditya Urjit Solutions LLP, India

PREAMBLE:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by and between **Bundelkhand University (BU)**, Jhansi, Uttar Pradesh, India and **Aditya Urjit Solutions LLP**, an Indian startup company, to collaborate on developing AI and ML software technologies for enhancing drone / GIS applications in agriculture.

The MoU aims to formalize a relationship where BU acts as an incubator to support the R&D and operational development of Aditya Urjit Solutions LLP, particularly in the fields of predictive artificial intelligence and precision agriculture.

ARTICLE 1: INTRODUCTION OF PARTICIPANTS

Bundelkhand University (BU), Jhansi

A premier state university established in 1975, recognized under UGC sections 12-B & 2(f), accredited A++ by NAAC, and funded under PM-USHA as a Multidisciplinary Education and Research University (MERU). BU houses a leading Innovation & Incubation Centre supporting more than 40 startups and over 100 patents.

Aditya Urjit Solutions LLP

An emerging Indian technology startup focused on developing AI and ML-based software for enhancing drone & GIS applications in agriculture. The company works on early disease detection, yield prediction, risk analysis, precision farming, sustainable practices to use Bio-fertilizer, Bio Pesticide, Pheromone, Neem oil and sustainable practices using predictive AI algorithms.

ARTICLE 2: SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

The MoU outlines the following areas of cooperation:

 Incubation Support: BU shall provide access to physical incubation space, mentorship, technical support, and academic expertise.





- 2. Joint Research & Development: Collaborative research in AI, ML, and drone technologies aimed at optimizing agricultural outcomes.
- 3. Access to Laboratories & Infrastructure: Aditya Urjit Solutions LLP may utilize relevant university resources, labs, and field-testing support, subject to availability and university policy.
- Pilot Projects: Execution of test cases and field trials involving drone technology / GIS in local or university-affiliated agricultural settings.
- 5. Training & Workshops: Conducting sessions for students and faculty to upskill in AI/ML applications in agriculture.
- 6. Intellectual Property (IP): Co-ownership of jointly developed IPs under mutually agreed terms; separate IP agreements may be signed as needed.
- 7. Funding & Grants: Joint applications to funding bodies for research grants and startup support schemes.
- 8. Sustainability & Impact: Promotion of sustainable agricultural practices through predictive AI systems, improving food security and reducing input costs.

ARTICLE 3: FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

Each party shall bear its own expenses unless otherwise agreed upon in separate agreements for specific collaborative activities. No financial obligation is implied by this MoU.

ARTICLE 4: EFFECTIVE DATE AND DURATION

This MoU shall come into effect upon the signature of both parties and will remain in force for **five (5) years**, subject to extension by mutual consent.

ARTICLE 5: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR)

Ownership and usage of intellectual property developed under this MoU shall be defined by separate IP agreements. In general:

- Sole developments remain with the developer.
- Joint developments will be co-owned under agreed terms.
- Commercialization shall follow mutual discussion and agreement.





ARTICLE 6: CONFIDENTIALITY

Both parties shall maintain strict confidentiality of shared data and project-related insights unless written consent is obtained for public disclosure.

ARTICLE 7: TERMINATION

Either party may terminate this MoU with sixty (60) days written notice. Projects in progress will be allowed to conclude unless otherwise agreed.

ARTICLE 8: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any disputes shall be resolved amicably by designated representatives. If unresolved, the matter shall be referred to an arbitrator mutually appointed by both parties.
