ABOUT THE JHANSI

One of the best administrators of Jhansi was Raja (King) Gangadhar Rao. In 1842 Raja Gangadhar Rao married Mannikarnika (Manu). After her marriage she was named as Laxmi Bai and become Jhansi Ki Rani (Queen of Jhansi) was led her forces against the British during Sepoy Mutiny of 1857. She sacrificed her life during this first struggle of the Indian Independence in 1858. Jhansi is well approachable through trains from everywhere in India. The atmospheric condition will be quite pleasant.

ABOUT THE TRAINING PROGRAMME

The Protection of Plant variety and Farmers Right Act, 2001 (PPVFR Act) is an Act of the Parliament of India enacted to provide for the establishment of an effective system for protection of plant varieties, the rights of the farmers and plant breeders, and to encourage the development and cultivation of new varieties of plants. This Act received the assent of the President of India on the October 30, 2001.

Plant Variety Protection (PVP) provides legal protection of a plant variety to breeder in the form of Plant Breeder's Rights (PBRs) that provide exclusive rights to breeder of the registered variety.

The Protection of Plant variety and Farmers Right Act (PPVFR Act), 2001 a sui generis system, is an attempt by the Indian Government to recognize and protect the rights of both commercial Plant Breeders and Farmers in respect of their contribution made in conserving, improving making available plant genetics resources for development of new varieties and to encourage the development of new plant varieties.

Protection of the plant varieties under the PPVFR Act, 2001 accelerates agricultural development and stimulates investment for research and development for the development of new plant varieties which in turn facilitates the growth of the seed industry and ensures the availability of high quality seeds and planting material to the farmers.

This training aims to throw light on the genesis, use and impact of PPVFR to farmers, academics and public in general.

पौधा किस्म और कृषक अधिकार संरक्षण अधिनियम 2001 के उद्देश्य

1. पौधा किस्मों, कृषकों और प्रजनकों के अधिकार की सुरक्षा और पौधों की नई किस्मों के विकास को बढ़ावा देने के लिए एक प्रभावी प्रणाली की स्थापना।
2. नई पौधा किस्मों के विकास के लिए पादप आनुवांशिक संसाधन उपलब्ध कराने तथा किसी भी समय उसके संरक्षण व उसके सुधार में किसानों द्वारा दिये गये योगदान के सन्दर्भ में किसानों के अधिकारों को मान्यता देना व उन्हें सुरक्षा प्रदान करना।
3. देश में कृषि विकास में तेजी लाना, पादप प्रजनकों के अधिकारों की सुरक्षा करना, नई पौधा किस्मों के विकास के लिए निवेश को प्रोत्साहित करना।
4. देश में बीज उद्योग की प्रगति को सुगम बनाना जिससे किसानों को उच्च गुणवत्ता वाले बीजों तथा रोपण सामग्री की उपलब्धता सुनिश्चित हो।

पौधा किस्म और कृषक अधिकार प्राधिकरण के सामान्य कार्य

- नई पौधा किस्मों, अनिवार्य रूप से व्युत्पन्न किस्मों, विद्यमान किस्मों का पंजीकरण।
- नई पादप प्रजातियों के लिए डीयूएस (विशिष्टता, एकरूपता और स्थायित्व) परीक्षण दिशानिर्देशों का विकास
- पंजीकृत किस्मों के गुणों का विकास व उनका प्रलेखन
- पौधों की सभी किस्मों के लिए अनिवार्य सूची पत्रीकरण (कैटालॉगिंग) की सुविधा
- कृषकों की किस्मों का प्रलेखन तथा उनका सूची पत्रीकरण
- उन कृषकों, कृषक समुदायों, विशेषकर जनजातियों और ग्रामीण समुदायों को मान्यता प्रदान करना और पुरस्कृत करना जो विशेष रूप से पहचाने गये कृषि जैवविविधता वाले हॉट-स्पॉट में आर्थिक रूप से महत्व पौधों व उनके वन्य सम्बंधियों से जुड़े पादप आनुवांशिक संसाधनों के संरक्षण, सुधार और परिक्षण के कार्य में संलग्न हैं।
- पौधा किस्मों के राष्ट्रीय रजिस्टर तथा राष्ट्रीय जीन बैंक का रखरखाव।
