### ORDINANCE AND SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

#### M.Phil. Physics

This academic programme shall run in the department of physics under the institute of basic sciences. This academic program shall be executed only in the university campus. This programme will have semester system of examination.

**1. Eligibility:** For admission to this programme the candidate must have passed M.Sc. Physics/Applied Physics/Electronics passed with at least 55% in aggregate.

**Note:** Relaxation of 5% in aggregate shall be given in eligibility criteria to marks of SC/ST candidate.

#### **2. Intake:**

Total number of seats in the programme shall be decided by the University from time to time.

**Note:** Reservation: As per reservation policy of the State Government/ University.

#### **3. Duration:**

The duration of the programme shall be of one year (two semesters). However, if a candidate passes the course in back papers, then he/she will have to complete the degree in two years. Thereafter his/her admission stands cancelled.


#### **4. Criteria of Admission:**

Admission to this programme shall strictly on the basis of entrance test conducted by the university. However, if the applicants are less in number, the admission can be given on the basis of merit in qualifying examination.

**Note:** A weightage of 15% of the percentage of marks obtained in entrance test will be given to those, who passed their qualifying examination from the college/university teaching department affiliated to Bundelkhand University.

### 6. Admission Fee:

(i) **Tuition and other fee:**

As prescribed by the University from time to time.

(ii) **Cancellation of Admission and Refund of fees:**

(a) Upon cancellation of admission the request for refund of fees should be made to the Vice-Chancellor, Bundelkhand University within three weeks after the deposition of the fees. On approval such candidate shall be entitled for refund of 50% of the prescribed fee.

(b) Request for return of fee shall not be considered under any circumstances, if made after three weeks from the date of deposition of Admission fee by the candidates.

### 7. Attendance:

The candidate must have attendance at least 75% of total lectures held in each paper/practical to become eligible for appearing in semester examination

However if a student having short of attendance due to illness, participation in sports, extracurricular activities etc the following rules shall apply.

(a) Shortage of attendance up to 10% shall be condoned by the HOD on the specific recommendation of the class teacher.

(b) A shortage of attendance up to 25% shall be condoned by the Vice-Chancellor on the specific recommendation of the Head of the Department.

### 8. Allotment of Specialization:

The allotment of different specialization should be made at the commencement of academic session on the basis of merit and choices of the candidates. The maximum number of candidates in particular specialization should not exceed the one third (1/3) of the total admitted candidates and minimum number should be two only.

### 9. Eligibility Criteria for Supervisor:

A teacher having Ph.D. degree in the subject/ allied subject can act as supervisor for M.Phil. dissertations. A scientist working in national labs/institutions can also become supervisor provided he/she holds Ph.D. degree in the subject.
